

Jeff is an experienced trial lawyer who has litigated a wide-variety of disputes for clients including Fortune 500 companies, high-frequency trading and investment firms, REITs, private equity firms, technology companies, and individuals and small businesses. Since 2018, Jeff has been ranked by Chambers & Partners as a recognized practitioner for general commercial litigation in Illinois.

Jeff spent ten years at Jenner & Block, where he was a partner in the Securities Litigation and Enforcement practice group and focused his practice on complex litigation and enforcement matters involving the financial services industry. Jeff, along with firm founder Chris Gair, represented the trustee for Sentinel Management Group, Inc. in dozens of lawsuits against Sentinel's former executives, clearing and custodial banks, brokers, auditors, and former customers, and succeeded in recovering hundreds of millions of dollars on behalf of Sentinel's creditors.
